Educational Goals 2022-2023

Public Act 48 of 2021, Section 98B requires local education agencies to establish educational goals expected to be achieved for the 2022-2023 school year.

Lowell High School (9-12) Goals:

All students will demonstrate proficiency in the content by earning 80% or better as an overall course grade.

All students will demonstrate proficiency in math/ELA by scoring at or above benchmark in the content area on the PSAT/SAT or equivalent measure.

Lowell Middle School (6-8) Goals:

All students will demonstrate proficiency in the content by earning 80% or better as an overall course grade.

All students will demonstrate proficiency in reading/math by scoring at or above benchmark on the NWEA (MAP) assessments.

Lowell Elementary (K-5) Goals:

Using the Acadience Summative Growth Report - All students will demonstrate typical reading progress growth or higher based on the assessments from the fall to spring testing period.

All students will meet NWEA growth targets in math and reading from Fall 2021 to Spring 2022 testing sessions
